

Motohub's Booking system- How it works.

Create an event - Via your backend portal

You can create different classes for the user to book into, e.g. if you were to run a bike day with 4 categories, you can create 4 categories i.e. "Slow, Medium, Fast, Race". Then the user can select which class or multiple classes to enter into. From here you create the live timetable, this can be changed live.

Once the event is created, **everyone** on the app will receive a push notification that you have created an event and the event will go live via the "Events calendar" page. This will help to increase your chances to fill the spots faster.

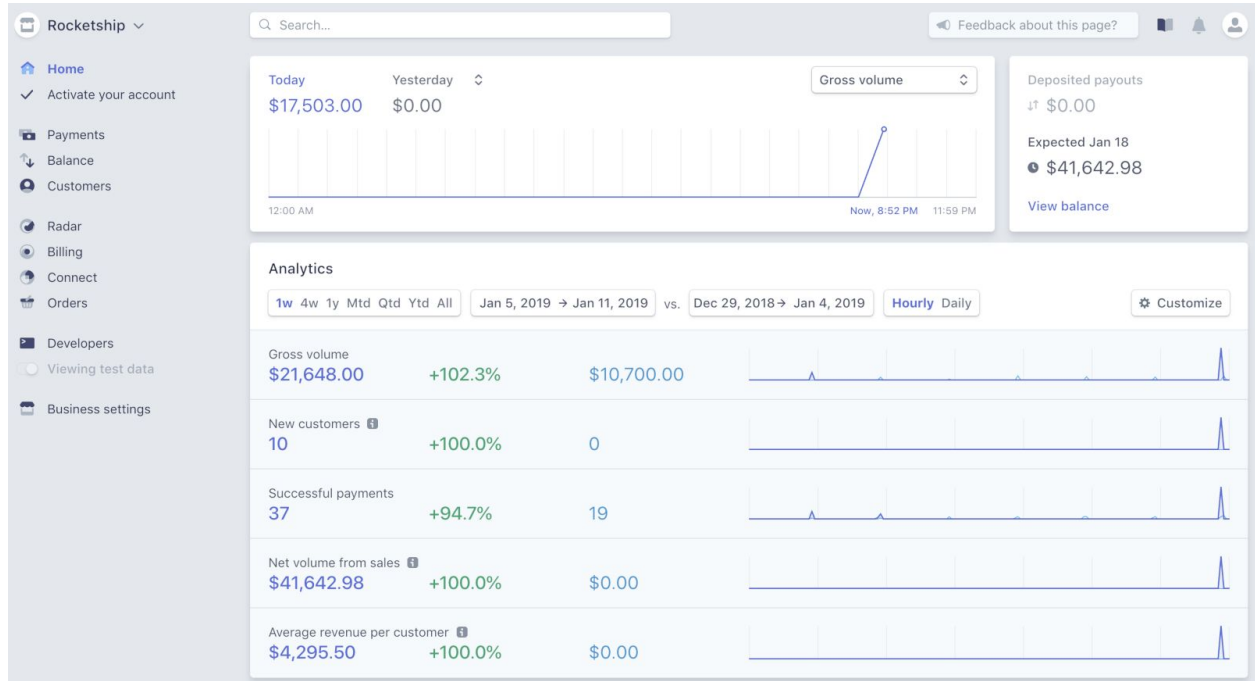

Payment

Payment is all done via the 3rd party secure payment gateway Stripe. The users pay via credit card through the app, The funds are deposited straight into your stripe account then released to your nominated bank account. There is a refund feature, where if the event is cancelled you can select that event and refund everyone instantly. This also has tracking and other features.



Motohub support and back end

All the entrants details that have booked in are all listed in your back end support. You can search for the entrances live via the backend and keep record by {ticking} the “on track” box at the event or print all the names if necessary.
